



RABBIT DROPPINGS

Looks like separate lumps, like nuts (hard to pass)



Increase MOVICOL dose*

TYPE 2

A BUNCH OF GRAPES

Looks like a sausage-shape but lumpy



Increase MOVICOL dose*

TYPE 3

CORN ON THE COB

Looks like a sausage but with cracks on its surface



Maintain MOVICOL dose*

TYPE 4

SAUSAGE

Looks smooth and soft like a sausage



Maintain MOVICOL dose*

TYPE 5

CHICKEN NUGGETS

Looks like soft blobs with clear cut edges (passed easily)



Decrease MOVICOL dose*

TYPE 6

PORRIDGE

Looks like fluffy pieces with ragged edges, a mushy stool



Decrease MOVICOL dose*

GRAVY

Looks watery, no solid peices (entirely liquid)



Stop taking MOVICOL* for a day or two
